Dear Colonel Miller and Lt. Colonel Acosta:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the Kirtland Air Force Base ("KAFB" or "Permittee") Quarterly Reports for 2019; Quarterly Monitoring Report for January- March 2019, Bulk Fuels Facility, Solid Waste Management Unit ST-106/SS-111, Kirtland Air Force Base, New Mexico, dated June 2019 and Quarterly Monitoring Report/or April -June 2019, Bulk Fuels Facility, Solid Waste Management Unit ST-106/SS-111, Kirtland Air Force Base, New Mexico, dated September 2019.

These reports only provide one quarter of data in the data tables of each report. Per NMED approval letter dated July 17, 2015 "Data presented in the tables [of Quarterly Reports] shall include the current data plus data from the three previous monitoring events or, if data from fewer than three monitoring events is available, data acquired from the three most recent monitoring events during previous investigations, if any, must be provided."

NMED is understands that there is reduced sampling every other quarter; therefore, all data

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presented in the tables may not require updating. However, the data provided in future quarterly reports must include the most recent sample event data and the data for the previous three events. For example, reports presenting data for wells on a reduced sampling schedule shall include the data for the 3 previous sampling events for wells sampled every other quarter.

The Permittee must implement these changes to the Quarterly Reports beginning with the First Quarterly Monitoring Report for January – March 2020, due June 30, 2020.
