Dear Colonel Miller and Colonel Acosta:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received the U.S. Air Force (Permittee) Kirtland Air Force Base (Facility) extension request (Request) for the *Work Plan to Relocate and/or Plug and Abandon the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (ABCWUA) Sanitary Sewer Line Within SWMU 6-2, Landfill 2 (LF-002)* (Work Plan), on January 3, 2020. The Request asks for an extension to allow the Permittee to undergo legal review because the sewer line belongs to ABCWUA. The Request was received a day after the work plan was required to be submitted. As stated previously in several extension request approval letters, all future extension requests must be provided a minimum of 10-days prior to the required submittal date. Failure to provide extension requests in a timely manner may result in denial of the requests.

NMED hereby grants the Permittee's request for a time extension and is extending the requested date from March 31, 2019 [sic] to June 30, 2020 because the legal review is likely to

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take longer than anticipated and NMED would like to minimize further extension requests for submittal of this document. The Permittee must submit the Work Plan and provide a schedule for relocating and/or plugging and abandoning the sewer line within LF-002 no later than **June 30, 2020**.
