If approved, the Agency will initiate a RCRA Class 3 permit modification to the KAFB RCRA permit.

Investigations and remediation, if necessary, of the addressed sites have been conducted under the Air Force Environmental Restoration Program in accordance with the RCRA Corrective Action program.

The following two sites are proposed for CAC status:

- CG-570 - Explosive Ordnance Disposal Hill
- CG-105 - Manzano Base Groundwater
