

The DSTP is the second submittal to the State of New Mexico in the ongoing effort to meet the requirements of the Federal Facilities Compliance Act. The information contained in the DSTP is based on the Mixed Waste Treatment Plan (MWTP) prepared by DOE-AL. The activities outlined in the MWTP are dependent on availability of funding. Therefore, funding cuts may impact the activities and schedules contained in the DSTP. We are looking forward to meeting with you to discuss the DSTP, and the associated issues.
