RE: Revision 3.0 to Federal Facilities Compliance Order, Exhibit A, Site Treatment Plan Compliance Plan Volume

Dear Mr. Plum and Mr. Hargis:

The purpose of this letter is to provide an updated Site Treatment Plan, Compliance Plan Volume [CPV] (Exhibit A to the Federal Facilities Compliance Order, October 4, 1995) as I had indicated in the January 28, 1997 letter. There are two attachments enclosed which incorporate changes from CPV Revisions 1.0, 2.0, and 3.0. Attachment one is the redlined and strikeout version where the new language is redlined or shadowed and the old language is struck out. This version of the CPV incorporates all changes made since the original CPV issued October 4, 1995. Attachment two contains only the new language for easy reading. The date of January 1997 appears at the top of the pages in this version because Revision 3.0 was finalized at that time. The CPV Amendment 1.0 has been replaced by Revision 3.0, so those changes are not shown within this version of the CPV.

Another item not incorporated into this version, which had been previously added (per the July 15, 1996 letter from Janice Archuleta to H. L. Plum, Department of Energy [DOE], and Micheline Devaurs, University of California, Los Alamos National Laboratory [LANL]) was the table listed in Section 3.4.1. This was the "schedule for development of lead processing techniques and options" which met the *June 30, 1996 Compliance Date* under *Activity A*. This schedule was submitted by DOE in the June 26, 1996 letter. Because the schedule contains new compliance dates, it should have been a revision to the CPV, however this was previously not done. In the version presented here, this schedule has been omitted to correct the error made in

the July 15, 1996 letter. Prior to this schedule being incorporated into the CPV, it shall have to undergo the revision process. The preferred method for accomplishing this is for DOE and UC to incorporate the schedule into the next revision request or the anticipated revision which will accompany the 1996 Annual Update to the CPV. Please let me know if this is acceptable.
