Subject: Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), Site Treatment Plan (STP) Activity 3.1.2C
 Notice of Completion of Off-Site Waste Shipment

The purpose of this letter is to notify the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) of completion of required activities set forth in the Federal Facility Compliance Order. Activity 3.1.2 C in the Compliance Plan Volume (CPV, Exhibit A) of the STP (as revised January, 1997) requires that, "*(W)ithin 45 days of receipt of waste at treatment facility,*" the Department of Energy (DOE) and the University of California (UC) "*(P)rovide documentation to NMED that waste was received at off-site facility.*" This letter follows the requirements of Section XX of the October 4, 1995 Federal Facility Compliance Order, issued to DOE and UC.

A shipment of Mixed Low-Level Waste that included two items of STP covered wastes listed in Section 3.1.2 of the CPV (Rev. 3.0, Exhibit A) in the treatability group "*soil with heavy metals,*" MWIR waste ID LA-W904, was made on September 29, 1997 and completed on October 1, 1997. Wastes were sent to the Envirocare facility near Clive, Utah. The STP currently requires DOE and UC to complete shipment of all wastes in Sections 3.1.2 of the CPV by December 29, 1997 (per amendment submitted on August 26, 1997, approved September 4, 1997).

As indicated in the following table, as of this writing, 48 of the 50 shippable items in this treatability group have been shipped off-site for treatment. Approval to ship the remaining two items has been requested from the Envirocare facility, and is pending resolution of Special Nuclear Materials (SNM) issues at Envirocare.






