Subject: Notice of Completion, Federal Facility Compliance Order (FFCO), Site Treatment Plan (STP), Compliance Plan Volume (CPV), Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), Activity 3.3C.

The purpose of this letter is to notify the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) of the completion of Milestone Activity 3.3C in the LANL FFCO, STP, and CPV.

This milestone activity consists of the completion of sampling and analysis for "mixed waste requiring further characterization or for which technology assessment has not been done," in the treatability groups, "Lead wastes - TBD," MWIR waste ID LA-W924, "Mercury wastes - TBD," MWIR waste ID LA-W925, "Compressed gases - TBD," MWIR waste ID LA-W926, "Biochemical laboratory wastes," MWIR waste ID LA-W927, and "Dewatered treatment sludge," MWIR waste ID LA-W928. The sampling and analysis activities included appropriate use of documentation reviews, visual inspections, waste item segregation, radiological characterization, and/or RCRA characterization, depending on the waste type and matrix. Some of the waste in these treatability groups has been shipped for treatment and disposal. The remaining waste items are currently being evaluated for treatment options.






