Subject: Notice of Completion of Off-site Waste Shipment, Activities 3.1.2 (B) and 3.2 (F) in the Site Treatment Plan (STP), Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL)

The purpose of this letter is to notify the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) of the completion of required activities set forth in the Federal Facility Compliance Order (FFCO). Activities 3.1.2 (C) and 3.2 (F) in the Compliance Plan Volume (CPV) of the STP require that, "Within 45 days of receipt of waste at treatment facility or within 45 days after completion of parallel option," the Department of Energy (DOE) and the University of California (UC) "Provide documentation to NMED that waste was received at off-site facility or provide notification of parallel option." This letter follows the requirements of Section XX of the October 4, 1995 FFCO issued to DOE and UC.

A shipment that included STP covered wastes listed in Sections 3.1.2 and 3.2 of the CPV (Revision 7.0) was made on November 18, 1998 and completed on November 19, 1998. Wastes were sent for treatment to the Waste Control Specialists (WCS) facility in west Texas. The total amount of STP waste shipped is 1.07 cubic meters. The STP waste shipped is described in the following table.

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


