Subject: Site Treatment Plan (STP), Compliance Plan Volume (CPV), Milestone Activities 3.4.1 C and 3.4.1 D, Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), Federal Facility Compliance Order (FFCO), October 4, 1995.


The purpose of this letter is to notify the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) of the completion of STP CPV Milestone Activities 3.4.1 C and 3.4.1 D. These activities required the Department of Energy (DOE) and the University of California (UC) to *"Complete shipment of wastes to decontamination operations, or determine treatment/disposal or other recycle options for lead waste not acceptable for decontamination"* by December 2, 1998.

DOE and UC have completed shipment of all lead for surface decontamination to on-site decontamination operations. The remainder of the waste in this category has been determined to be suitable for off-site shipment to a recycle facility. DOE and UC have obtained a contract with a commercial off-site facility and are pursuing shipment. A few remaining items consisted of waste that is not amenable for decontamination. These items will be proposed for transfer to the appropriate treatability groups during the upcoming Annual Revision. In addition, a few items were missing and will be proposed for transfer to the *"Missing/nonexistent/TBV"* category during the next Annual Revision.

Enclosed is a Certification Statement prepared in accordance with the requirements of Section XX, *"Documents, Information, and Reporting Requirements,"* of the FFCO.

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


