

Subject: Notice of Completion, Federal Facility Compliance Order (FFCO), Site Treatment Plan (STP), Compliance Plan Volume (CPV), Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), Milestone Activity 3.2 (G).

The purpose of this letter is to notify the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) of the completion of Milestone Activity 3.2 (G) in the LANL FFCO, STP, CPV.

This milestone activity consists of completion of the sampling and analysis plan for "mixed waste requiring further characterization or for which technology assessment has not been done," in the following treatability groups: "Mercury Wastes-TBD," MWIR Waste ID LA-W925; "Explosives," MWIR Waste ID LA-W932; and "Labpacks," MWIR Waste ID LA-W933. The sampling and analysis plan includes activities such as documentation reviews, visual inspections, waste item segregation, radiological characterization, and/or RCRA characterization, depending on the waste type and matrix. The sampling and analysis plan was written in advance of the compliance due date of January 30, 1999.

Enclosed is a Certification Statement prepared in accordance with the requirements of Section XX, "Documents, Information, and Reporting Requirements," of the FFCO.




