

Subject: Documentation Required in Letter of Approval for Expedited Treatment Opportunity, Site Treatment Plan (STP), Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL)

The purpose of this letter is to submit the documentation required in your letter of approval for expedited treatment of STP waste dated August 5, 1999. Your approval was granted based in part on savings to be realized by the Department of Energy (DOE) and the University of California (UC) by expediting the shipment to the Envirocare facility in Cleve, Utah, and upon the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) receiving a detailed description of the seven waste items and a copy of the waste profile from Envirocare. This documentation was required by NMED within fifteen days of receipt of the letter of approval.
