Subject: Notice of Completion of Offsite Waste Shipment, Activities 3.1.3 (B) and 3.1.6 (B) in the Site Treatment Plan (STP), Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL)

The purpose of this letter is to notify the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) of the completion of required activities set forth in the Federal Facility Compliance Order (FFCO). Activities 3.1.3 (B) and 3.1.6 (B) in the Compliance Plan Volume (CPV) of the STP require that, "(w)ithin 45 days of receipt of waste at treatment facility or within 45 days after completion of parallel option," DOE and the University "(p)rovide documentation to NMED that waste was received at off-site facility or provide notification of parallel option." This letter follows the requirements of Section XX of the October 4, 1995, FFCO, issued to the Department of Energy (DOE) and the University of California (UC).

A shipment that included STP covered wastes listed in Sections 3.1.3 and 3.1.6 of the CPV was made on January 25, 2000 and completed on January 26, 2000. Wastes were sent for treatment to the Waste Control Specialists (WCS) facility in west Texas. The total amount of STP waste shipped is 0.22 cubic meters. The STP waste shipped is described in the following table.

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




