- 6/92-6/93** EPA/DOE/LANL Negotiate Federal Facility Compliance Agreement (FFCAgreement) for All LANL MW
- 3/15/94** EPA, DOE Sign LANL FFCAgreement Following Public Comment
- 3/31/95** LANL Submits Proposed STP (PSTP) to NMED
- 4/17/95** NMED Issues PSTP For 90-Day Public Comment Period
- 8/17/95** NMED Issues Draft Final STP For Public Comment
- 10/4/95** NMED Issues Final STP As Part of FFCO;
FFCAgreement Terminated
