The purpose of the memorandum is to document the telephone conversation that occurred on April 14, 2006 between Albert Dye, Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Federal Facilities Compliance Order, (FFCO), Project Manager and Lee Winn, NMED FFCO project manager.

Mr. Dye telephoned inquiring if it was necessary to submit a request for expedited treatment on a waste that was proposed as an addition to the 2005 Site Treatment Plan, Revision 16. Mr. Dye believed this request was necessary because the 2005 Site Treatment Plan has been submitted to NMED but not yet approved.

After discussion of this matter with Mr. John Kieling, NMED's Permits Management Program Manager, and reviewing the LANL FFCO, it was determined that the expedited treatment request was unnecessary. Specifically, if an expedited treatment request was submitted in fiscal year 2006 for a 2005 waste, this would confuse the reporting for the 2006 Site Treatment Plan Revision 17 (due by March 31, 2007).

Mr. Dye was informed of the is decision by telephone on the same date.
