Dear Messrs. Dye and Stewart:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the above-cited letter submitted by Los Alamos National Security (LANS) and the U.S. Department of Energy (the Respondents) and referenced by ENV-RCRA-07-068. NMED has reviewed the document and identifies the following inaccuracies.

Comment #1:

Paragraph two in the above-referenced letter incorrectly references a manifest number, the date the waste shipment was completed, and the facility where the waste was shipped. The letter states, "[a] shipment that included STP covered waste was initiated on March 5, 2007 and completed on March 8, 2007. This waste was sent to PermaFix in Florida under manifest number 61277." The waste manifest number is 62177 not 61277. The manifest shows M&EC as the receiving facility, not PermaFix. The waste shipment was completed on March 9, 2007, not March 8, 2007. Correct all of the discrepancies.

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


Comment #2:

Paragraph three incorrectly references the date on which the waste shipment was completed and the facility where this waste was shipped. It states, “[a]dditionally, a second shipment of STP covered waste was initiated in March. This shipment was sent to ME&C in Oakridge TN under manifest number 62176.” The manifest states that PermaFix as the receiving facility, not ME&C. The waste shipment was completed on March 8, 2007, not March 9, 2007. Correct all of the discrepancies.
