**RE: REQUEST FOR ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD FOR PROPOSED REVISION 19.0 OF THE LOS ALAMOS NATIONAL LABORATORY FEDERAL FACILITY COMPLIANCE ORDER SITE TREATMENT PLAN, COMPLIANCE PLAN**

Dear Ms. Perry-Piper:

I received your letter dated November 19, 2009 addressed to Pam Allen of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) requesting a copy of the Administrative Record (AR) associated with Public Notice 09-04 published November 17, 2009 concerning proposed Revision 19.0 of the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Federal Facility Compliance Order Site Treatment Plan (STP), Compliance Plan.

I am not including the AR as you requested, which consists of approximately 1150 pages. The public notice stated that a copy of the AR is available for review in Santa Fe at the address in the letterhead above, as well as electronically online at <http://www.nmenv.state.nm.us/HWB/lanlperm.html> under the heading "Federal Facilities Compliance Order." If you do not have personal access to the Internet, you should be able to obtain access from your local public library in order to review the AR online. Please contact me if you still want all or part of the AR copied and mailed to you. The cost for copying is \$0.25 per page.

Your letter also requested a written response to this question:

*In reference to 2 of Kieling's November 17, 2009 "Dear Interested Person" letter, what was the milestone compliance date for Activity 3.1.4 (A) for waste Treatability Group LA-W919 in Part III ("Compliance Plan") of the FFCO STP?*



Prior to submittal of proposed Revision 19.0, there was no milestone compliance date for this mixed low-level waste (**MLLW**) treatability group, because all waste in this group had been shipped offsite in prior years. However, a single container of previously covered mixed transuranic (**MTRU**) waste in the Chemistry and Metallurgy Research/Technical Area 55 inventory was reclassified as MLLW during waste characterization, and as MLLW it requires a milestone compliance date. There are no (and have never been any) specific milestone compliance dates for MTRU waste designated for disposal at the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant in the STP. The proposed date for this MLLW treatability group is December 31, 2010. This information may be found on pages 160-161 in the "clean" version of the September 30, 2009 version of the LANL STP update submittal.
