Subject: Request for Extension for Submittal of Site Treatment Plan, Fiscal Year 2018, Update and Proposed Revision 29.0, Federal Facility Compliance Order

Dear Ms. Briley:

The purpose of this letter is to request an extension for submittal of the Los Alamos National Laboratory Federal Facility Compliance Order Annual Site Treatment Plan (STP) Update for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 (hereafter, the FY 2018 STP Update). The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is required to submit the annual STP update to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) on or before March 31 of each year. The DOE Environmental Management Los Alamos Field Office (EM-LA) and National Nuclear Security Administration Los Alamos Field Office (NA-LA) are working with their respective contractors (Newport News Nuclear BWXT – Los Alamos, LLC [N3B] and Triad, LLC) (collectively known as the Respondents) to develop the FY 2018 STP Update.

Delays associated with the FY 2017 STP Update are impacting the preparation of the FY 2018 STP Update. On December 6, 2018, NMED sent a letter titled “Disapproval, Resubmittal of Site Treatment Plan, Fiscal Year 2017 Annual Update and Proposed Revision 28.0, Federal Facility Compliance Order, October 4, 1995.” NA-LA/Triad resubmitted the FY 2017 STP Update on January 11, 2019; the January version has not been approved yet. Additional time for the FY 2018 STP Update will enable the Respondents to verify and validate the FY 2018 data per the Respondents’ discussion with NMED on February 21, 2019. The Respondents’ intent is to deliver a high-quality submittal that will not require repeated reviews by NMED.

For the reasons above, the Respondents respectfully request an extension until May 31, 2019, to submit the FY 2018 STP Update.
