SUBJECT: Disposition and Destruction of Contaminated Equipment.

1. Reference is made to the draft of your memo dated 15 July 1946 from H. I. Group to Members of CMR Division, subject, "Disposition and Destruction of Contaminated Equipment."

2. I believe it to be a very well written memorandum. Although it is not pertinent to the purpose of the memorandum, I am sorry that it seemed desirable to delete a warning to members that when property is transferred as outlined in Paragraphs 2, 3, 5, and 6, care should be taken that proper property credits are received whenever possession of the property is relinquished by one individual and picked up by another individual. I feel that much of the trouble individuals have concerning property is due to oversight or negligence at some prior time rather than in deliberate or reckless indifference to property procedures.

3. This memorandum is indicative of the highly commendable manner in which you are attempting to control proper disposition and destruction of contaminated equipment.
