DISPOSAL OF CONTAMINATED TRASH

REFERENCE: LAB-CMR-12

In a letter to Herb Drager, May 3, 1948 I informed him I was requesting F. S. Smith to post the contaminated trash truck with the following danger designations and to set up the safety procedure listed below concerning monitoring of the contaminated trash truck. Please proceed with this as rapidly as possible.

1. Warning signs (Contaminated Truck - Danger - Keep Off) will be placed on each side, front, and rear end of the truck. The present signs will be removed and replaced with smaller, but just as conspicuous signs, (2' x 1½').
2. No other warning device, such as siren, red light, etc. will be installed or used on the truck.
3. All deliveries of contaminated trash to the dump will be monitored by an H. I. man who will follow close behind the truck in the H.I. sedan. The sedan will carry no danger designation.
4. The truck convoy is not to exceed any speed limit set up for normal traffic.
5. After completion of the fenced in parking lot, the truck will be kept in the lot, and the fence locked, at all times the truck is left unguarded.
