REVISIONS TO PROCEDURES COVERING THE CONDEMNATION AND DISPOSAL OF
CONTAMINATED PROPERTY FORM 252-R
SP-2

0745 General

It has been necessary to revise Paragraph 207.3b of the Supply and Property Procedure Manual. This paragraph covers the procedures used to dispose of contaminated property when using the subject form.

In the past, Paragraph 207.3b did not call out the two situations where it is not necessary to list the monitoring results. Paragraph 207.3b, as revised, will have the following statements added:

"There are two occasions where monitoring results will not be shown:

1. Items contaminated with high explosives. This fact must be stated on the form.
2. Items contaminated with radioactive materials on the inside only, when it is not practical to dismantle the item to arrive at a numerical monitoring count. H-1 will describe on the form the extent of the radioactive contamination in lieu of a numerical monitoring count."

It is requested that H-1 continue to comply with number two above. These revisions to the SP Procedure Manual will be published at a later date.
