Reference is made to your memorandum of June 11, 1956, under the above subject, and the attached map also herewith returned.

I am not fully convinced that there has been an official burial ground at the present GT Site, but I recall distinctly that during the construction of our new site the excavation crews have "discovered" buried material which was covered up immediately. Checking with various members of this Laboratory (I believe it was Harry Allen) somebody remembered that this might have been a "cemetery" for the junk collected by the old gun crew located at the Anchor Ranch. I have taken the liberty of indicating this location to the best of my knowledge on the enclosed map.

I thought that I should focus your attention to this item; again, not knowing if there are also contaminated waste parts buried or not.
