Transmitted herewith are a set of prints in preliminary form of "Material Disposal Areas", Drawings ENG-R 3636 thru ENG-R 3650.

*General*

We solicit your assistance with regard to the preparation of a brochure of record drawings related to materials disposal areas within the project, by reviewing this set of prints and adding any applicable comments you feel should apply to the final set of drawings, including information relative to materials disposal areas that you may know of, not shown in this set of prints.

The brochure will consist of a set of reduced size drawings, bound in loose leaf binders of approximately 9½" x 15" (such as our Structure Location Plan Book), and will cover the entire subject matter of pit and shaft locations, construction specifications, record information, etc.

In addition to your general comments, we would also appreciate specific comments concerning the following questions:

1. Drawing ENG R 3637

- (a). Item 6 under General Notes refers to marking the limits of Indian Ruins by use of 4" x 4" wood posts painted white and extending 4' above ground.

Is this manner of limits demarcation sufficient? Or should some type of wire be included; if so, what type, or how many strands, etc.

- (b). Item 8 under General Notes, in part, specifies installation of warning signs, pit area and pit marker signs, etc., shall be as directed by H-Division personnel.

Are signs available to H-Division? Or only thru ENG-4?

2. Drawing ENG-R 3639

We will attempt to show in detail on this drawing various shaft cover specifications and details, shaft location posts and safety chains, shaft diameters, depths, information and procedures for lined and unlined shafts, etc.

Are there any other special or additional details, not listed above, which should be included on this sheet?

The information relative to the above could be of such extent that it might require additional drawings.

3. Drawings ENG-R 3640 thru ENG-R 3650

Under the word "Reference", we note Field Book numbers, and in many cases L.A. Notebook numbers.

While this information is clear if one refers to Items 9 and 10 under General Notes on drawing ENG-R 3637, should this note be repeated on each individual drawing?

4. Drawing ENG-R 3642

(a). Under the word "Legend", is the symbol and wording of "Pit Station Marker Signs" correct and clear? ✓

(b). Should we be concerned with the diameters and depths of all shafts? Should this information be noted on the drawing?

5. Drawing ENG R 3647

Should we be concerned with the diameters and depths of each shaft? Should this information be noted on the drawing?


