General

The following comments and answers are in reply to your memorandum of May 25 on the above subject.

We have only two general comments. We believe it would be appropriate to have complete orientation on all roads. For example, listing the road destination would give a quick orientation for the casual reviewer. Many of the roads are listed in this manner. In reviewing the preliminary plans, reference for the grid network was not given and is not obvious to us. Perhaps it is the Zia bench marks which are generally used throughout the county.

In reply to your request for answers to your specific questions they are as follows:

- 1 (a). We suggest that Fred Worman be consulted on marking the limits of Indian Ruins.
- (b). Group H-5 prefers to leave the question of the signs marking pit areas, etc., to Groups H-1 and H-3.
2. We do not believe there are special details to be added to this sheet.
3. We do not believe this note should be repeated on each individual drawing.
- 4 (a). This is clear to us.
- (b). We believe this information should be noted in the drawing.
5. We believe the diameters and depths of each shaft should be noted in the drawing.
