General


The attached maps have been reviewed; numbers and letters below refer to items in memo of May 25, of the same subject. Comments are as follows:

1.
  - (a). White posts alone are inadequate for marking Indian ruins unless posts are well-marked, as by burning "Indian Ruin" on several faces and painting the inscription a contrasting color.
  - (b). Signs are installed as directed by ENG-4. Wording on the signs will be determined by H-Division personnel in consultation with ENG-4.
2. Liquid wastes? I would like to discuss the meaning of "shaft" at length and in greater detail.
3. Reference numbers should be repeated on every drawing in brief form, as Field Book F 2J2A, PGS 62 & 63, (ENG-3), LA Note Book 9593 (Health Div., SP. 2).
