

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General

The U. S. Department of Energy (DOE), Los Alamos National Laboratory site has completed its evaluation under Phase 1 of the Comprehensive Environmental Assessment and Response Program (CEARP). This assessment examined inactive waste disposal sites, current waste management practices and compliance with applicable Federal, State and local environmental regulations. The Phase 1 CEARP report provides documentation for Phase 1 of the DOE Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) and various U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) pre-remedial activities.

A meeting is scheduled for 9:00 a.m., October 22, 1987, in the U. S. Department of Energy Area Office, Room 100, to present and discuss the Phase I report with the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency, New Mexico State Environmental Improvement Division, U. S. Park Service, U. S. Forest Service, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Pueblo de San Ildefonso, and Pueblo de Santa Clara.
