Dear Mr. Anderson--

Yesterday I spoke first to Mr. Roy Haarman, Deputy Engineering Division Leader at LANL, and then to Mr. Eloy Nunez in your office, concerning the above-referenced map. Mr. Haarman and Mr. Nunez advised me to write you to formally ask for this map, which apparently is readily available to Mr. Haarman.

As Mr. Nunez may have indicated to you, I have been reviewing recent environmental submittals made by DOE and LANL to the State Environmental Improvement Division; these submittals contain maps of local areas which show a grid but are otherwise difficult, in many cases, to locate relative to each other and to visible landmarks. The reason I am requesting the above map is to give those local maps a context.

If there is a (modest) reproduction charge I will be happy to pay this. Mr. Nunez thought indicated to me that there would probably be no charge for a single reproduction.
