Dear Dr. Davis:

As required by the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) portion of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit No. NM0890010515 issued to Los Alamos National Laboratory, enclosed herewith are documents describing current field sampling and laboratory analysis procedures. This is a requirement of Special Condition No. 7 of the permit. Two paper copies and one electronic copy\* of the following documents are provided:

- o "Test Methods for Evaluating Solid Wastes" (EPA SW-846)
- o "Environmental Restoration Program Standard Operating Procedures"
- o "Quality Assurance Program for Water, Soil, and Sediments, and Water Supply at Los Alamos National Laboratory"




