To Interested Parties:

In accordance with the procedures set forth in the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and implementing regulations, the Department of Energy has issued a proposed Finding of No Significant Impact (Finding) on its proposal to consolidate certain nonnuclear manufacturing functions of the Nation's nuclear weapons complex. The proposed Finding is based on the "Nonnuclear Consolidation Environmental Assessment", released in June 1993 (Document No. DOE/EA-0792).


The Department invites the public, including affected States and American Indian Tribes, to comment on the proposed Finding. The Department is making the proposed Finding available for public review for 30 days prior to making its final determination, and before taking any action on the proposal. The proposed Finding and the Executive Summary of the Environmental Assessment are enclosed.
