The Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the latest draft of the Remedial Action Plan (Plan) that was attached to your October 15, 1993 letter. Upon review of the Plan, HRMB has determined that it is acceptable from a technical standpoint. The NMED's management team involved in the settlement negotiations will have to make a final determination as to the acceptability of the proposed Plan along with the other features of the settlement process.
