Dear Mr. Garcia:

Enclosed is a copy of the Hazardous Waste Management Division RCRA Program Standard Operating Procedure for Corrective Action Management Units (CAMU) requests. This document describes the use of the CAMU process for regulated facilities in Region 6. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) would like to work closely with the New Mexico Environment Department on any CAMU application. Please examine the timelines associated with document review and determine how NMED would like to interact with EPA in the review process. Once agreement is reached on state participation in this process, EPA would like to formalize this agreement in a letter to NMED.

EPA would also like to provide training for you staff on the CAMU SOP and the final rule. Per discussions with Barbara Hoditschek and Steve Alexander, agreeable dates for this training would be April 21 or 22. EPA would like to conduct half-day training on the CAMU rule and half-day training on the RCRA Corrective Action process.
