AIP staff attended the initial information workshop meeting for the SWEIS at Los Alamos High School. Stakeholder participation consisted of about 15 people. The meeting was facilitated by Dede Collins, Gloria Cordova and Brian Thompson. The prime speaker was David Rosson (DOE/AL) who cited directly from a prepared set of slides what the SWEIS is and why DOE will be conducting one at LANL. At the end of Mr. Rosson's presentation the audience was asked to comment on any major aspects of the proposed SWEIS. There were no significant Stakeholder comments. Mr. Rosson explained that a series of topics concerning the SWEIS would be covered in informational workshops (see attachments) during September, and October 1994:

- 1) Chemical and Metallurgical Research Building (CMR), 9/21, 9/28, 10/12
- 2) Weapons Research, Development and Test Program and related facilities, 9/22, 9/29, 10/13
- 3) Nuclear Materials Program and Related Facilities, 9/21, 9/28, 10/12
- 4) Waste Management (Treatment and Storage) and related facilities, 9/21, 9/28, 10/12
- 5) Waste Management (Disposal) and related facilities, 9/22, 9/29, 10/13
- 6) Environmental Restoration, 9/22, 9/29, 10/13
- 7) DOE land transfers within Los Alamos County (This topic will be discussed only on 10/13 at Los Alamos), 9/22, 9/29, 10/13

On August 10, 1994, an Advance Notice of Intent (ANOI) was published in the Federal Register expressing the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) desire to prepare a Site-wide Environmental Impact Statement (SWEIS) for the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL). LANL is a DOE multidisciplinary research and development laboratory located in Los Alamos, New Mexico.
