

NATIONAL LABORATORY**

The process of selecting a Citizens' Advisory Board to represent Northern New Mexico on Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) environmental issues is well underway. The primary mission of this Board is to provide community comments and informed recommendations to the Department of Energy (DOE), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the New Mexico Environment Department, concerning the regional effects of health, safety, environmental management, and defense programs of LANL activities.

A Formation Committee of five citizens was established by DOE as an independent group to select the members of the Citizens' Advisory Board. The Committee will select approximately 12-17 people who represent the communities surrounding LANL, and submit their names to DOE for approval. The Committee has drafted a Mission Statement, Operating Procedures and other documents, which are available for public review. Applications are being solicited through a public process, including newspaper, radio and television announcements; meetings with interested groups, government and Tribal officials; and advertised public meetings. To date, we have held six public meetings in communities around Northern New Mexico. Please look for more public meetings in March and early April. If you or your organization would like to meet with the Formation Committee members, please contact the Formation Committee Office.

In order to be considered for membership on the Citizens' Advisory Board, we must receive your application by April 20, 1995. The Formation Committee will then begin their selection process.


