DISCUSSION:

- 1. NM authorization for HSWA

A Fed. Reg. Notice will be placed in June or July. It will describe the HSWA authorization, and will not discuss the job share between EPA and NMED. The length of the job share will probably be between 2 and 3 years. The state will determine whether a permit modification is required or desirable.

- 2. QAPP

B. Driscoll is having the QAPP reviewed by EPA offices in Houston and Las Vegas, to get opinions on the sufficiency of the proposal to reduce the number of QA samples. B. Driscoll hopes to receive comments this week, and will notify the ER Program by phone if there is a decision made (she will be on vacation the next two weeks).

- 3. Letter from EPA to J. Arthur on D&D/ER funding split.

The letter is in concurrence. T. Taylor requested that a sentence be added that indicates that LAAO and UC are developing scenarios for D&D funding of \$10M, \$5M, and \$0M, and that the EPA, DOE, and UC staffs will work on the matter to ensure that high priority ER sites are not deferred.

- 4. Prioritization and FY96 funding.

T. Taylor suggested a meeting be held the week of June 19-23 between the ER Project and EPA/NMED to discuss (a) status of ongoing work, (b) proposed new work for FY96, (c) budget situation, and (d) D&D scenarios, with regard to understanding the proposed FY96 program and the status of high and medium priority sites. B. Driscoll agreed that the meeting would be a good idea.
