**Site Specific Advisory Board**  
**Los Alamos National Laboratory**

- \* Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) has formed a site specific advisory board called the Northern New Mexico Citizens' Advisory Board which will address environmental management issues at the facility.
- \* There are 18 voting members on the board which were picked by a formation committee. The members represent most of the major stakeholder groups in the area.
- \* Four ex-officio members who represent DOE, LANL, NMED and EPA have also been designated.
