Los Alamos National Laboratory has begun the process of developing a Watershed Management Plan. We feel that it is important to involve the organizations that share the Pajarito Plateau Watershed in this planning process in order to identify areas where integration and coordination are possible. This letter is an invitation to attend an introductory meeting on September 16 at 1:30 to 4:30 at Fuller Lodge in Los Alamos.

The meeting has three primary objectives. The first objective is to present our preliminary strategy and approach to watershed management, which was described in our Draft Watershed Management Plan.
