The purpose of this letter is for the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and the University of California (UC) to provide additional maps in response to the New Mexico Environment Department's (NMED) Request for Information (Mr. James Bearzi, Hazardous Waste Bureau, dated February 12, 2001) and pertaining to the Los Alamos National Laboratory, EPA ID NM 0890010515. These maps are part of DOE/UC's response to Request No. 18, as specified in DOE/UC's letter of March 1, 2001.


