About Getting to Santa Fe, Tour and Transport Options

Downtown Santa Fe is a very walkable, compact area and a car is not a necessity for visitors. If you choose not to rent a car, the following airport shuttles serve Santa Fe from Albuquerque, 60 miles away, or from the Santa Fe airport. If you drive to/from the Albuquerque airport, allow about 2 hours because of highway construction in mid-Albuquerque.

Two companies run shuttles to/from Albuquerque airport to/from various Santa Fe hotels, from about 5 a.m. to 11 p.m. daily:

1. Herrera's Santa Fe Shuttle, 1-888-833-2300 -- \$38 round-trip; \$21 per person, one way
2. Sandia Shuttle Express, 1-888-775-5696 (474-5696 local); \$35 round-trip if prepaid by credit card, or \$40 cash; \$20 per person one way

One company provides service from the Santa Fe airport to downtown:

Roadrunner Shuttle, \$11 per person, one way, Tel. 505.424.3367. They meet every arriving flight.

Tour Options, August 29-30

Vans will depart the Hilton Hotel at 8:30 a.m., Wednesday, Aug. 29, for tours of the Los Alamos Laboratory site, areas affected by the Cerro Grande fire, and downtown Los Alamos. The amount of time for each tour (all day vs. half-day) depends on your interests and whether or not you plan to visit the WIPP site in Carlsbad, NM. (Los Alamos is about 45 mins. from Santa Fe; Carlsbad is 300 miles from Santa Fe.)

WIPP has arranged a 4-hour tour for SSAB Chairs Meeting registrants on Thursday morning, August 30, beginning at 8:45 a.m. Their tour coordinators can suggest places to stay overnight, as Carlsbad is a 5-hour drive from Santa Fe. If you are interested in the WIPP tour, you might consider booking your return from El Paso (TX), as it is about 2.5 hours from Carlsbad, as opposed to 4 hours back to Albuquerque. However, this can increase your airfare.

It is possible to do the ½ day tour of Los Alamos on 8/29, with a box lunch on the van, and return to Santa Fe earlier, allowing you to drive to Carlsbad for the 8/30 WIPP tour. If you let us know of your interest, we'll try to coordinate arrangements with WIPP and will assist with car-pools.
