I understand that NMED has reviewed voluminous environmental data supplied by LANL. I hereby request the results of that review, specifically on known RCRA exceedences, the hazardous materials involved, their locations, possible sources of those constituents, relevant regulatory levels and any corrective action plans that NMED might issue concerning those exceedences.

I would like this information as soon as possible (with the exception of possible corrective action plans). I submit that this information is clearly in the public interest. It is also directly relevant to the pending LANL RCRA permit and any corrective action plans that NMED might be contemplating. In fact, I don't understand how NMED could be considering corrective action plans under RCRA/HSWA without this information at its fingertips.
