Rich,

There is no separate Transfer Agreement (TA) for B-4, as B-4 was incorporated into B-2 (they are contiguous and were surveyed as one tract).

I will get the TA for B-2 and send it to you. I have a hard copy, not an electronic copy, as changes were made prior to the signing. Please let me know if you want me to fax you a signed copy. This tract was transferred to the Department of the Interior on Oct. 23.

I don't have deeds for C-1 and C-2 at this time. In fact, the NM Highway Dept. has not indicated any interest in receiving any land tracts, although they indicated by phone that they are reviewing the EBS/CERCLA documents. I will be in contact with Los Alamos County, to find out if the county will discuss this matter with the Highway Dept., as the Highway Dept. is the designee of LA County. I don't know whether DOE will ever convey the "C" tracts to the Highway Dept, and if we don't, then the tracts will be conveyed to LA County.

I will keep you posted on any developments on the "C" tracts.
