SUBJECT: FINAL RADIOACTIVE CONTAMINATION SURVEY CLEARANCE ON CERTAIN STRUCTURES IN TA-1

The structures reported below were monitored for the final time in some cases and reviewed in others. Regardless of how it was done, the recommendations provided here should be considered as final.

TA-1-30 (HT - Barrel House) - Remove to the contaminated dump and burn. No contamination could be detected but the oil and oil saturated wood floor is suspected of being contaminated because of its association with old HT (uranium) Building. The quenching basket, charcoal, etc., that were used in the process still remain. There are three 55 galle drums full of oil in the structure that should also be disposed of in the contaminated dump.

TA-1-31 (HT Gas Storage) - No contamination. OK to sell.

TA-1-56 (Sigma Bldg.) - Under H-1 and Fire Department surveillance, remove to contaminated dump in sections and burn. Some of the dirt near the north security fence will have to be removed to the contaminated dump. There would appear to be quantities of building equipment such as overhead cranes, an elevator, and electric motors that may be salvageable and we suggest that such equipment be monitored after removal from the building during demolition. This may save on our dump space and give some monetary return to the government.

TA-1-57 (Cooling Tower) - No contamination. OK to sell.

TA-1-96 (Bldg. M-1) - Floor drains are suspect. Suggest drains be sent to the contaminated dump. The building itself is free from contamination and OK to sell.

TA-1-98 (Bldg. K-1) - No contamination. OK to sell.

X TA-1-103 (Warehouse #19) - Remove sump pump and exit

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
