**USES GIVEN TO BUILDING AT S-SITE HELD BY ZIA DURING 40s AND 50s**

I had a lengthy conversation in my office with Bill Francis on 03-11-94 on the subject of the uses given to buildings at S-Site that were held by ZIA during the 40s and 50s. According to my notes of the meeting he had arrived in Los Alamos in July of 1947 and worked as an engineer under Sam Musser, who was chief of ZIA's "Tech Area Division" that took responsibility for building maintenance throughout the lab. He became Sam's assistant in 1949 and took over Sam's position in 1963. He was in charge of S-Site facility maintenance, but did not reside there. He remembered that ZIA had had a satellite shop on the old road to S-Site and indicated that HE was not brought there, though detectable traces of it might have been there just from peoples clothes. He agreed to provide a written summary of the practices used to keep HE from the ZIA satellite, and it is attached.

He gave a number of names of ZIA employees who had worked there, namely:

- Jerry Huber - Delivered fuel for ZIA
- James Caldwell - Handled all work orders until retired in 1970, and answered emergencies
- Buddy Pal - On site with Utilities Division
- Glenn Bryant - with Utilities Division
