As a result of our 6/28/99 field inspection at the location formerly known as the Tar Site (C-00-041) the following actions have been completed. The small amount of visible tar/asphalt remaining were removed from the drainage channel above Rendija Canyon and a standpipe drain was installed below the Ponderosa Estate subdivision to control storm event run-on into the drainage channel. The standpipe drain was designed to effectively use the natural drainage basin below the subdivision as a retention area, while dissipating flow from large storm events into the downstream drainage channel of concern.

The actions completed at C-00-041 include the removal of source material, reseeding and the establishment of complete vegetative cover, installation of rock check dams within the channel and installation of the standpipe drain to address run-on concerns. The site meets the EPA criteria for a site that has achieved final stabilization. A final BMP close out inspection was performed on 8/20/99.

The Environmental Restoration Project has proactively completed the actions described above. The USFS and LAAO have concurred that no further actions will be performed at PRS C-00-041 by the ER Project and all future concerns should be addressed by the Ponderosa Estate Homeowners Association and the USFS.
