Re: TA-49 Area 12 Bottle House and CPTF Building Removal

Wednesday, October 3, 2007:

Darrik Stafford, Group Leader for FIRP-DISP, and Kristi Beguin discussed the removal of the TA-49 Area 12 Bottle House building 49-23, and the Area 12 Cable Pull Test Facility (CPTF) building 49-121. Mr. Stafford stated that the buildings were removed on February 28, 2006. The building removals were performed by TSAY Corporation. Wastes were generated as a result of the building removals and consisted of four waste streams. The roof was managed as asbestos-containing material (ACM) and was disposed of at the KEERS landfill in Mountaineer, NM. Non-hazardous and non-radioactive industrial debris was disposed of at the Waste Management landfill in Rio Rancho, NM. Scrap metal was sent for recycling. Used oil was recovered from the equipment in the bottle house and was sent for recycling. This oil was tested for radiological constituents and PCBs and neither were detected. All wastes were screened for radioactivity, and radioactivity was not detected in any of the waste streams.
