Hey Debbie,

Construction was actually completed on June 27, 2002. At that time all disturbed areas had been re-seeded, however there were two areas where the vegetation did not take. These areas were probably 200 ft² each. They were re-seeded in late 2002, and by the end of spring 2003 these areas were also fully vegetated.

The wind erosion sampling equipment is located on the closed facility (i.e., on top of the cover). The network is centered approximately around where shafts 1 & 2 are/were (not on purpose). The sampling network probably extends onto the southern edge of Pit 2 and onto the northern edge of Pit 4 (at the east end of each of these pits).
