Hi

I have never heard of someone burning solvent with HE in it. I have heard of burning HE in "popping" furnaces. Some guidance on that situation is given in RO 12979, 12117, 11873, 12887, and especially see 13265 (which talks about Solvents contaminated with explosives that have the potential to detonate can be open burned.)
