Subject: Notification of Los Alamos National Security, LLC Signatory Officials and Authorized Representatives for the Solid Waste Disposal Act (SWDA), the New Mexico Solid Waste Act (SWA), the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act (HSWA), and the Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA).

This letter provides an update to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 6 on the signatory authority for the operator of Los Alamos National Laboratory, Los Alamos National Security, (LANS), in relation to the above-referenced laws.

In particular, this letter identifies the LANS signatory officials and duly authorized representatives for certifying and signing documents required under the compliance programs for solid waste, hazardous waste, and toxic substances, pursuant to the Solid Waste Disposal Act (SWDA), the New Mexico Solid Waste Act (SWA), the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act (HWA), and the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA).

The positions of Associate Director of Environmental, Safety & Health (ADESH) and Division Leader of the Environmental Protection and Compliance Division (EPC-DO) are hereby identified as LANS' signatory officials under 40 CFR 270.11 (a) and similar regulations for certifying and signing permit applications and documents required under these solid waste, hazardous waste, and toxic substances laws.

In addition, the position of Group Leader of the Environmental Protection and Compliance Programs Group (EPC-CP) is hereby designated as an authorized representative under 40 CFR 270.11(b) and similar



regulations to sign reports and other information as may be required or requested by EPA and NMED under these solid waste, hazardous waste, and toxic substances laws.
