

This letter is a partial response to questions posed by Mr. Ronald L. Butters, Internal Evaluation Officer, Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), in a letter to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), dated October 30, 1985.

Our response deals only with the question of whether or not LANL is listed on the EPA list of violating facilities for the hazardous waste regulations during FY 84 and FY 85.

Answers to Mr. Butters other questions have been addressed by separate correspondence.

LANL had violations of the hazardous waste regulations for groundwater monitoring and closure plan.
