Dear Mr. Season:

The New Mexico Environmental Improvement Division (EID) has received your response to the June 18, 1990 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. Based on our review of the information submitted, we have determined that Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) has adequately addressed the violations cited in the referenced NOV letter. Therefore, we are closing out the enforcement action regarding the NOV, pending a certification from LANL that the waste in the TA 53-1 tank has been removed and taken to an appropriate facility. This certification should include a manifest or other documentation detailing when the waste was removed and how and where it was disposed. Once the information concerning the tank is provided, the NOV can be considered finally resolved.
