






Dear Mr. Horst:

We have received your letter dated March 3, 1992, in which you requested that two maps pertaining to Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) be provided. The first requested map would be generated at a scale of 1:24,000 and have the following characteristics: (1) topography with contour interval = twenty feet; (2) technical area locations and boundaries; and (3) locations of monitor and production wells, galleries, and other surface water stations. The second map would be identical to the first but would exclude topography.

LANL is presently preparing the maps as requested, and we plan to submit them to you before the middle of May 1992. Please contact Jon Mack of my staff at 665-5026 if you have questions concerning the status of the maps.
