During the most recent stakeholders meeting hosted by DOE on May 3, 1994 concerning National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) issues at the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), I requested a list of all sites and units at LANL which are and would be subject to Environmental Assessments (EA's) and/or Environmental Impact Statements (EIS's). I requested that the NEPA status as well as the cost of each project be provided. This verbal request was directed to Mr. Jerry Bellows and Ms. Diana Webb. Mr. Bellows and Ms. Webb indicated that such a list would be forthcoming, although no date of submission was provided.
